On its ReverbNation page, Thunderosa bills itself as "greasy Texas stomp." I ask you, loyal reader. Do you expect me to ignore a band that identifies itself that way? You know I cannot. So what makes this band a fit for this particular slot? Well, this band isn't trashy like most of the lo-fi bands we feature. It's trashy in the way Nashville Pussy is. This is a

band that believes in loud guitars and vocals in songs about hot rods and drag racing. If you want a good example of the trashy aspect of this band, listen to "Crushed." You know who I think would like this song? Early Cuyler from *Squidbillies*. Frankly, I want to see an episode of *Squidbillies* that features this song.
